



Faith (The real depth of relationships)


Grace (Give people more than they deserve)

The **Army of One** is a program of LIVE-IT Ministries that works with local government and other agencies who regularly come in contact with the elderly and others in need. These agencies make referrals to LIVE-IT who visits them, determines the resources needed to meet the need, then contacts volunteers and churches to meet these needs.



LIVE-IT's new program **MyRide Sevier County** is designed to provide Sevier County seniors, 60 years and older, with much needed transportation. Rides to doctor appointments, pharmacies or grocery stores can help them maintain their independence, enabling them to lead a healthier, more productive life and therefore a happier one.
